



Iowa Ready Mixed Concrete Association 2020 Scholarship Program (Colleges)

The Iowa Ready Mixed Concrete Association (IRMCA) is pleased to announce its 2020 Scholarship Program. Scholarships will be awarded to college students seeking degrees in areas of study relating to careers in the ready mixed concrete and construction/engineering industries. The amount of each scholarship is determined annually by the IRMCA Scholarship/Educational Outreach Committee. Scholarships will be awarded in March 2020 at IRMCA's Annual Convention. In 2019, IRMCA awarded twenty scholarships ranging from \$1,000 to \$5,000 to deserving students.

CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY:

- Student must be enrolled at an accredited two- or four-year institution of higher learning in Iowa, or any school with a concrete construction related program. (e.g. civil engineering, construction engineering, construction management)
- Student shall have attained sophomore status or higher (as of November 30, 2019).
- Student must be pursuing a degree in an area of study that would benefit his or her preparedness for a potential career in the ready mixed concrete or construction/engineering industries.

SELECTION PROCESS:

- Selection of scholarship recipients will be made by the IRMCA Scholarship/Educational Outreach Committee. The awards will be based on the applicant's demonstrated academic achievement, financial need, area of study as it relates to the industry, and other achievements and activities.
- While all eligible students will be considered for award, the Iowa Ready Mixed Concrete Association reserves the right to give preference to applicants who are:
 - Residents of the state of Iowa
 - Planning to live and work in Iowa after college
 - Related to an employee of an IRMCA member company
 - Experienced in the ready mixed concrete industry
- Scholarship recipients will be notified in December and invited to attend the IRMCA Annual Convention in March 2020.

SUBMITTAL:

Scholarship applications may be downloaded from www.concretestate.org. Eligible applicants should submit the *IRMCA Scholarship* application and an approximate 1,000 word essay outlining career goals, objectives, and insight as to why applicant is considering employment in the ready mixed concrete industry, and/or other related fields such as construction or engineering. Completed applications can be mailed, faxed, or emailed to the IRMCA office no later than **November 30, 2019**.
