



2021 Jerry Woods IRMCA Scholarship

In honor of longtime Iowa Ready Mixed Concrete Association (IRMCA) Director of Training and Outreach Jerry Woods, the IRMCA Board of Directors has established the *Jerry Woods IRMCA Scholarship*. This scholarship will be offered to qualified students who are or will be pursuing a major course of study in the building trades, including concrete technology and practice, at a local Iowa community college.

One- to Two-Year scholarships are available at a minimum of \$2,500/year.

(Student must maintain a 2.5 GPA, or equivalent, to be eligible for the second-year scholarship.)

CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY:

- Student must be entering or enrolled in their first year at an Iowa community college or tech school building trades program, including concrete technology and practice.
 - Recipients currently enrolled in Spring 2021 will receive a scholarship for the 2021-22 academic year. Students enrolling in Fall 2021 will receive a scholarship for the 2021-22 academic year and will be eligible to receive it for the second year in 2022-23.
- Student must be a resident of the state of Iowa.

SELECTION PROCESS:

- Selection of scholarship recipients will be made by the IRMCA Scholarship/Educational Outreach Committee.
- Personal interviews may be conducted to determine the recipients.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified in May and the recipients (and parents) will be invited to attend the IRMCA Annual Convention in March 2022.

SUBMITTAL:

The *Jerry Woods IRMCA Scholarship* application may be downloaded from www.concretestate.org. Eligible applicants should submit their completed application and an approximate 1,000 word essay describing their enthusiasm for a career in concrete construction through employment in the ready mixed concrete, construction, or engineering fields.

Completed applications can be mailed, faxed, or emailed to the IRMCA office no later than **April 1, 2021**.
