








2024-2028 Iowa Highway Program

Pavement Modernization

Allamakee US 18/52/IA 51

- 1.3 miles in Postville
- Pavement Rehab/ADA Improvements @ \$1.5 million

Allamakee IA 76

- 19.1 miles from West Main St in Waukon to MN State Line
- Pavement Rehab @ \$1.2 million

Bremer IA 3

- 3.8 miles from 0.1 miles East of Cedar River Parkway to U.S. 63
- Pavement Rehab/Paved Shoulders @ \$2.4 million

Bremer US 63

- 8.2 miles from 0.55 miles south of C33 to 2 miles south of Chickasaw County Line (SB)
- Pavement Rehab @ \$3.6 million



Pavement Modernization

Bremer IA 188

- 10.1 miles from WCL of Plainfield to U.S. 63
- Pavement Rehab @ \$1.5 million

Butler IA 57

- 0.8 miles in Aplington from 13th Street to 4th Street
- Pavement Rehab @ \$793,000

Cerro Gordo I-35

- 30.6 miles from Franklin County line to 1.0 mile north of B35
- Pavement Rehab @ \$2.5 million

Clayton IA 56

- 10.6 miles from Fayette County line to WCL of Elkader
- Pavement Rehab @ \$2.8 million

Fayette IA 3

- 1.4 miles in Oelwein from NCL to 9th Avenue SE
- Pavement Rehab/Diamond Grinding @ \$943,000

Fayette IA 56

- 12.0 miles in West Union from IA 150 to Clayton County line
- Pavement Rehab @ \$3.2 million

Fayette IA 150

- 7.8 miles from West Union to Winneshiek County line
- Pavement Rehab @ \$3.6 million

Franklin IA 3

- 8.4 miles from I-35 to 0.15 miles west of WCL of Hampton
- Pavement Rehab/Paved Shoulders @ \$5.8 million








